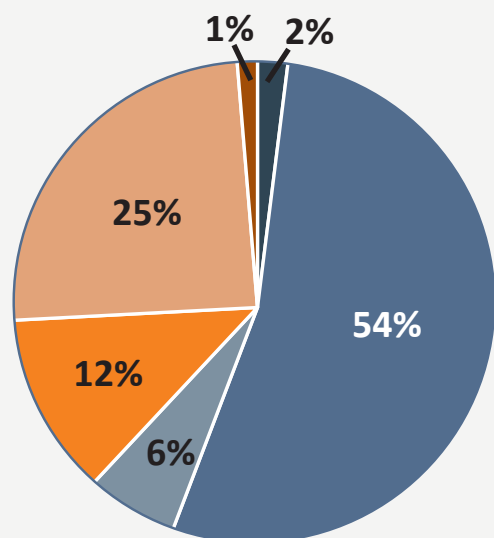

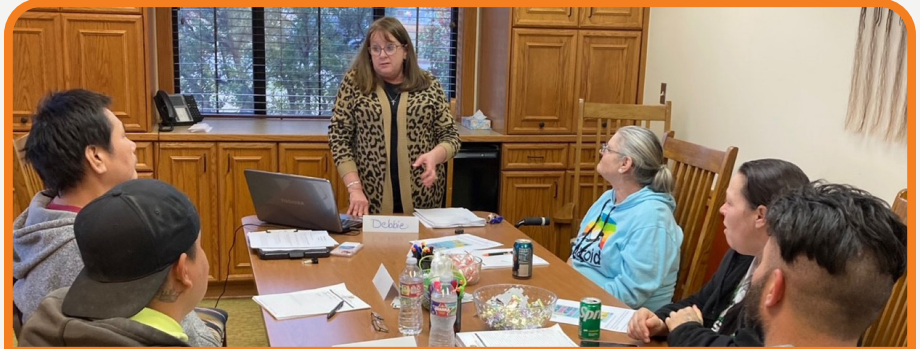
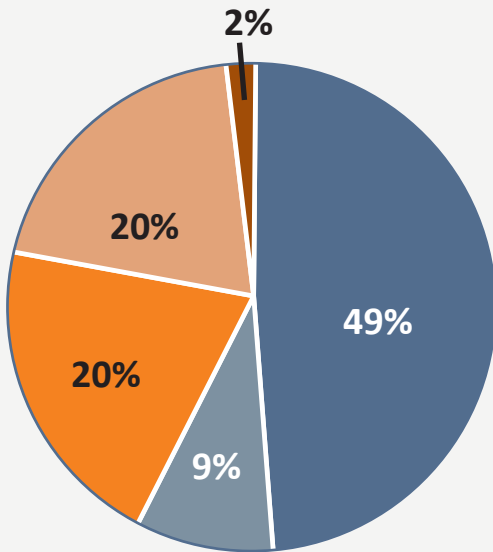

TOTAL PERCENTAGE OF LOAN ORIGINATIONS



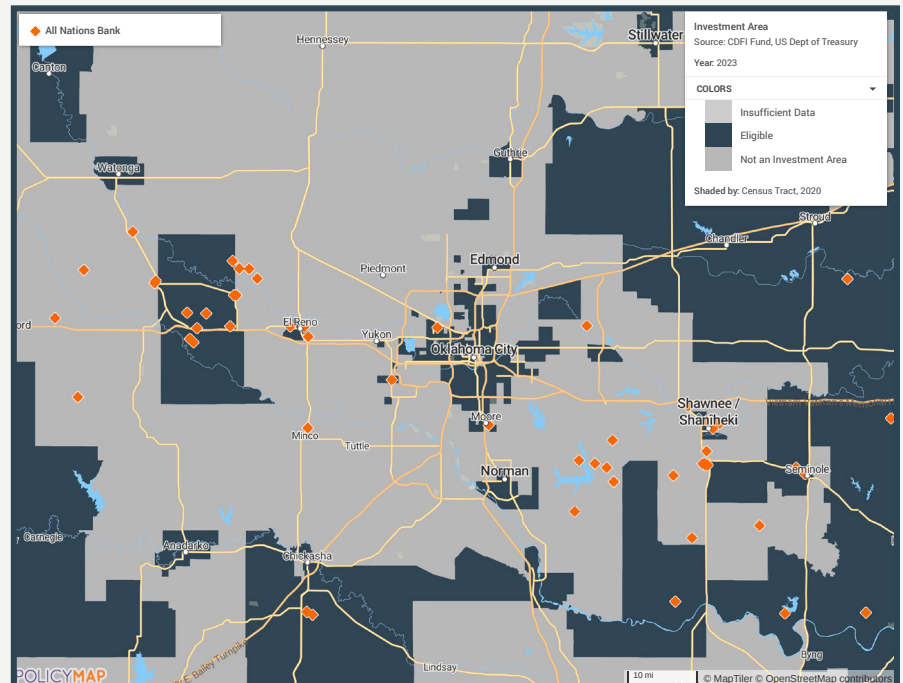
Financial Literacy Initiatives

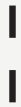

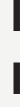

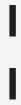

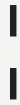
